- Added new hand sanitation stands throughout the property
- Added 36 new wall mounted hand sanitizing stations throughout the property.
- Added small bottles of hand sanitizer for guest distribution
- Added individual packs of disinfectant wipes for distribution at check-in
- Increased the number of times public areas – counter tops, door knobs, railings and other high use areas – will be cleaned with disinfectant per shift

Please continue to follow the CDC and WHO recommendations of washing hands with soap frequently, wipe down areas that have been used by others, and remain approximately 6 feet away from others.
