COPY OF PANAMA CANAL BIRTH OR DEATH CERTIFICATE

Your request must be notarized and include a copy of a valid, government-issued photo identification of the requester. Please include the following in your request:

All Consular Vital Records cost \$50 per document.

- 1. A notarized written (or typed) request that includes all of the following information:
- Date
- Purpose of Request
- Full name at birth/death/marriage
- Location of birth/death/marriage
- Signature of subject/parent/legal guardian/legal representative
- Address and daytime telephone # of requesting person

- For birth records, also include
- Father's full name, date and place (city/state and country) of birth
- Mother's full name, date and place (city/state and country) of birth.
- Any U.S. passport information
- 2. A copy of requester's valid identification
- 3. A \$50.00 check or money order for each copy requested.
